Are Host Families paid?

Hosting For Short Stay 1-10 week students.

AlliU pays a nightly stipend to our Short Stay 1-10 week Host Families to help cover the day-to-day, food and accommodation expenses of hosting a student.

Host Family nightly compensation varies based on location, meals and sometimes other amenities or considerations.

Host Families are paid in a two-week cycle, with funds transferred directly into the nominated bank account. Host Family stipend is Tax Free.

All AlliU students have their own spending money and are fully insured. Students are expected to cover costs outside their host family's usual outlay.

Hosting for Long Term Exchange students 3-12 months.

Host Families are provided with a small expense offset to help cover the cost of living.

All students have their own spending money and are fully insured. Students are expected to cover costs outside their Host Family's usual outlay.

Are Students insured?

Yes.

All students are covered by Mandatory health insurance. Many students also have additional insurance.

What support will we receive during the students' stay?

Hosting For Short Stay 1-10 week students.

Host Families have an extensive, experienced support network to call upon should they experience any issues during a student's program.

Your main source of support will be the AlliU Group Coordinator, otherwise known as the GC. The GC will get to know both your family and the student to ensure a pleasant experience for both parties.

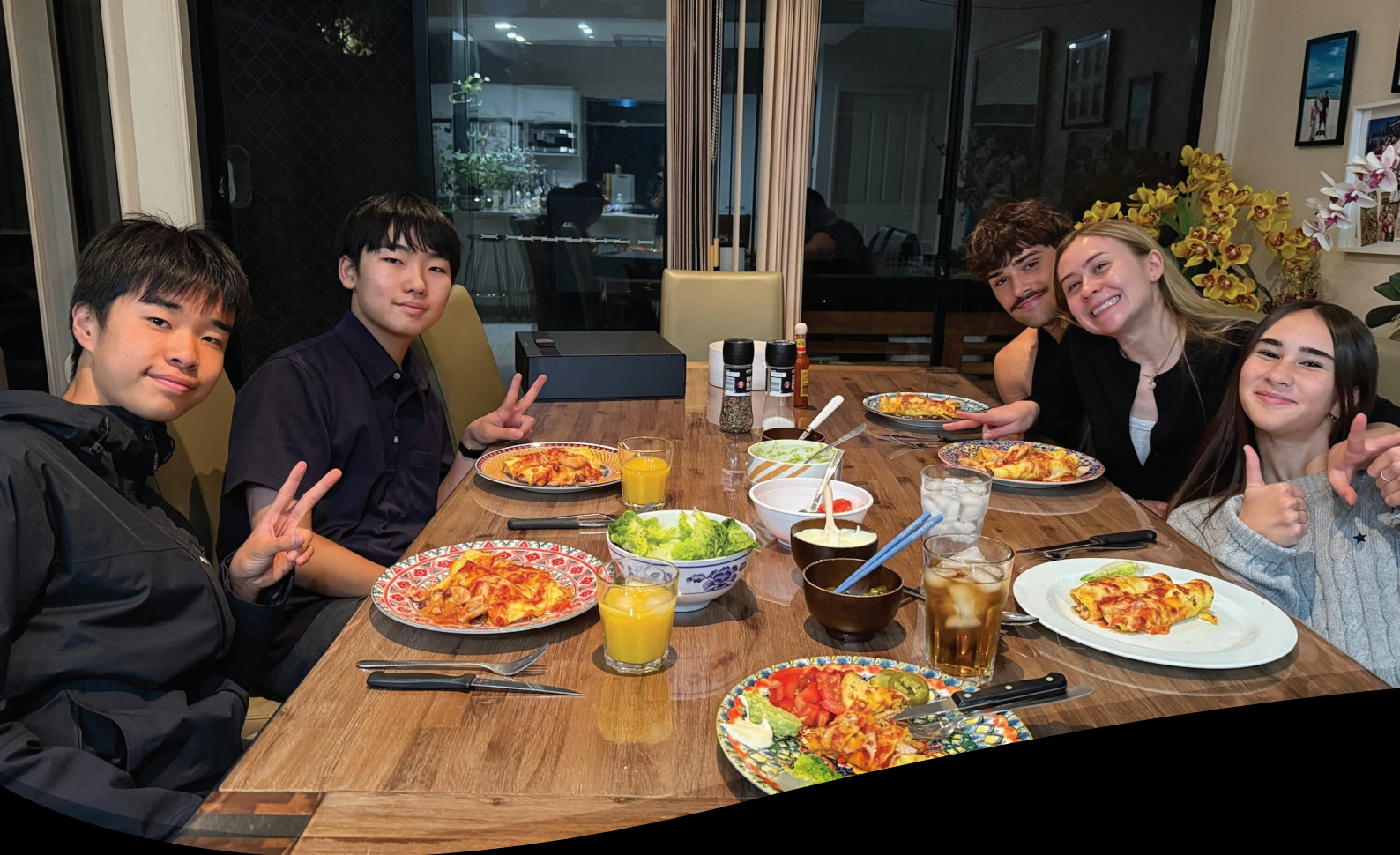
AlliU also provide around-the-clock student contact with the State's Regional Manager.
