Since 1987, AllU has supported and provided [Study Tour](#) and [Student Exchange Programs](#) for over 80,000 International students from countries around the world. We have welcomed International students from Japan, China, Korea, Canada, France, Germany, Italy, with many more destinations to come.

Outbound Student Exchange Programs enable eligible students from Victoria, Queensland and Western Australia to travel to and study in the aforementioned countries, gaining valuable international and cultural experiences.

AllU's Inbound Programs welcome International students to Australia to experience Australian education, culture and international exchange.

AllU's homestay and study tour programs provide affordable opportunities for international students to improve their English language skills while allowing them to experience the Australian way of life and culture.

Host Families and Host Schools benefit from the cultural and educational experiences of AllU's programs learning about a different culture.

AllU aims to promote understanding, friendship and kindness through the interactions of different nationalities, cultures and languages within homes, schools and communities.

Inbound Study Tours

Study Tours provide a great opportunity for groups of primary and secondary students to spend time with an Australian family, while undertaking English language and cultural classes.

Our study tours are a great opportunity to improve your English abilities, experience another culture and to promote friendship across the world.

Short term tours last between 6-10 days and up to 10 weeks.

Long term tours are offered from 12 weeks to the full school academic year.

Tours include:

- Intensive English classes based in state or private high schools
- Full-day and half-day excursions tailored to suit your requirements
- Interaction with Australian students
- Stay in homestay with Australian families

During their time in Australia, students can experience some of Australia's unique cultural aspects and history.

We appreciate the vital role our Study Tour program plays in enhancing students' English proficiency. AllIU consistently strives to deliver an educational program that satisfies all requirements.

Premium Study Abroad Program

Students can study in the country of choice from Australia, Canada, Japan, France, Germany and Italy with many more destinations to come.

Cost involves full payment of school fees and a nightly hosting stipend to Host Families.

No exchange criteria needed.

AIIU and our International partners take care of all arrangements and tailor make a program that suits your requirements.

AIIU currently facilitates outbound secondary student exchange programs for eligible students enrolled in Queensland, Victoria and Western Australia only.

AYP Program Student Exchange

AIIU offer volunteer homestay and school programs for the duration of for durations of 3, 5 or 12 months *(or discuss other durations with us if required)*.

AIIU AYP student exchange is currently available in Japan, Canada, France, Germany, Italy.

Students are hosted within a single placement. This program is very cost effective for all students.

Available to both Inbound and Outbound students.

Students will truly experience life as an International student, attending normal core classes, electives and activities.
